### **WAGES:**

We do remain far apart on This new language this issue, but we again keep up with inflation or other Level 2 hospitals as **EXTREME** or UNREASONABLE.

#### **BREAKS:**

WSNA stands firmly against the accusation that metal detectors and increased security are **EXTREME** and UNREASONABLE.

#### WORKPLACE **VIOLENCE:**

WSNA proposed the stronger language for the committee and management only agreed after nurses spoke out about the committee's failure to protect staff.

#### **SAFETY:**

proposed by Providence do not see increases that Kadlec involves a 9-month evaluation process that in the end, guarantees nothing to the nurses aside from committee recommendations.

#### **BENEFITS:**

Benefits committee language was also proposed by WSNA in response to the change from Blue Cross/Blue Shield to Aetna.



## WHAT IS REALLY HAPPENING...

- Break relief RN's: Management continues to push the failed "Break buddy" system while claiming 95% compliance using flawed Kronos data.
- Safety Measures: Management called metal detectors and additional security "extreme." We call them common sense.
- Pay and Fairness: Many nurses are still not being paid at the correct step for their years of service.
- Retirement Cuts: Providence Kadlec has reduced 401(K) contributions costing nurses hundreds to thousands annually, but claim our wage proposals aren't realistic.

## WE ARE CLEAR...

- It is not extreme or unreasonable to demand safety and respect in our workplace!
- It is not extreme or unreasonable to want a system that ensures nurses get their breaks!
- It is not extreme or unreasonable to expect nurses to be paid appropriately and fairly.
- Receive a bargaining union status update,
- · Come meet and learn with our negotiator,
- Discuss upcoming actions for negotiation.
